

Job Description Food Technician

Job Purpose

To be responsible for preparing for practical lessons, assisting during lessons where necessary and clearing up after practical lessons.

Maintaining high standards of food hygiene in the food classrooms.

- To ensure items are laundered where necessary and equipment cleaned after use.
- To ensure all demonstration materials, equipment and provisions are available for use by the teaching staff.
- To carry out minor repairs and maintenance of kitchen equipment where possible and arrange for specialist outside companies to attend to more complex problems.
- To give support to teachers in preparing theory work.
- To support in practical lessons practical lessons as directed by Subject Leader.
- To be available to assist at any time with any problem that arises in the Department.
